Attributes Core Strengths to its Outstanding Revenue Growth

"We have used our remote cource lighting technology, to develop, adapt and transition our products into the emergine needs of new markets," said Mr. Tomasi. The company's Rapid Develoment Center expediendtly deisgns, manufactuers and deliver functional prototypes that facilitate a steady stream of new, cost-effectie products to the marketplace.

RSL uses fiber optics, high efficiency light sources and beam shaping optics to create electricity-free lighting devices that eliminate EMI/RFI emissions, can be all non-metallic to reduce rust and corrosion, and can be very small and lightweight to minimize radar cross section and topside weight for both the United States and Italian navies. It's commercial line includes explosion-proof lighting, methane and temperature monitoring sensor systems, and active illumination warning systems for outlining equipment, safety vests and suspenders, and personal flotation devices.

To qualify for the Marcum Tech Top 40, companies must have had operating revenues of at least \$50,000 in 2009 and \$3,000,000 in 2012, be headquartered in Connecticut, and own proprietary technology or proprietary intellectual property that contributes to a significant portion of the company's operating revenues; or devotes a significant proportion of revenues to the research and development of technology.
